Natural Church Development is a process for corps to evaluate where they are and what is their weakest area. This is known as the minimum factor.

The corps will invite 30 people to complete a survey form and the results will evaluate 8 quality characteristics.

- Gift Based Ministry
- Passionate Spirituality
- Effective Structures
- Inspiring Worship Services
- Holistic Small Groups
- Need Oriented Evangelism
- Loving Relationship

From the survey a minimum factor will be highlighted and this then becomes the area for the corps to work on and then complete another survey 18 months later.
